Inquiry: Our Inquiry topic this Term is Mana where we explore the strengths we have. This topic ties in nicely with the school-wide Mitey programme inspired by Sir John Kirwan where students focus on emotional and mental health.


Writing: This Term Writing fits in with our Inquiry topic which is Mana. We are exploring autobiographies, a pepeha, poetry and quick writes.


Assessment Methods

- 3. Writing samples in Terms 1 and 3.
